In keeping with Fox's commitment to the highest, cutting-edge broadcast standards, we encode and multiplex HDR and SDR signals in HEVC for the games on the Fox network, and we also multiplex and transmit Fox's Home Run Productions for other games in the Pac 12, Big 10, and Mountain West Conferences.

## Scoring Big With the NHL

For the second consecutive year, as part of our partnership with Telstra Broadcast Services, PSSI International Teleport (PIT) will be a pivotal point-of-presence in the contribution and distribution of the full season of NHL live games and highlights.

The NHL manages an extensive connectivity network of wired venues in both the U.S. and Canada. The NHL season includes 1,300 games, and select daily games are identified for distribution to international broadcast partners. Using the extensive redundant connectivity to Telstra's GMN managed fiber network, PIT receives a complement of backhauls and fronthauls that are recorded, frame rate converted, and onpassed to Europe and Asia through satellite, fiber and IP routings. We also manage the dozens of daily point-to-point and point-to-multipoint bookings that weave these games to a multitude of locations worldwide.

PIT has purpose-designed several NHL workstations with state-of-the-art routing and multiviewed stream and video monitoring. With the number of simultaneous games per day in the double digits, additional uplink and IP encoding requirements are accommodated into this workflow to scale up as needed.

We are proud to partner with Telstra on these exciting projects, and we look forward to another successful NHL season!
